Acrosphere Aerial and Acrobatics Policy

Welcome to Acrosphere. We are committed to providing a safe, supportive, and professional training environment. By joining our classes, you agree to uphold the following rules and regulations.

Membership in Squad is subject to adherence to all Acrosphere standards of commitment, professionalism, and representation. Participation in the Squad requires consistent attendance, engagement in training, and conduct that reflects the values and reputation of Acrosphere both within and outside the studio environment.

Conflict of Interest Policy:

To maintain the integrity, safety standards, and proprietary training methods of Acrosphere, members are not permitted to participate in circus training, instruction, or coaching activities at external studios, organisations, or programs without prior written consent from Acrosphere management. This includes both recreational and professional involvement. Any external engagement that may present a conflict of interest must be formally disclosed and approved in advance. Failure to comply with this policy may result in review of membership status and potential removal from programs.

1. Choreography & Routine Usage

- All choreography, routines, and act creations learned at Acrosphere remain the intellectual property of Acrosphere.
- Permission must be obtained from the studio before performing any Acrosphere routines outside of the studio.
- When posting routines or acts on social media, credit must be given to Acrosphere and the studio must be tagged.
- If an act is required for external use, a buyout fee applies:
 - £2,000 per act (studio buyout rate)

2. Clothing & Appearance Policy

- Participants must wear appropriate layered clothing for aerial training to ensure safety and comfort.
- Hair must be tied up or in a plait at all times to avoid entanglement in equipment.
- No jewellery or accessories that may cause injury or damage to equipment are permitted.

3. Studio Etiquette

- Parents and guardians are not permitted in the studio during classes unless prior permission has been given.
- Respect for instructors, fellow participants, and studio equipment is expected at all times.
- Parking only outside our studio - two spaces and on main road, please Do Not park at the doctor's surgery on weekdays.

4. Safety & Liability

- Before signing up to any class, participants (or parents/guardians for under 18s) are required to read and agree to our full Terms & Conditions which are clearly stated on our website.
- Aerial and acrobatic training involves inherent risks, and while Acrosphere takes every precaution to ensure safety, risks cannot be fully eliminated without compromising the nature of the activity.
- Practicing at home or outside of the studio is done at your own risk, and Acrosphere accepts no liability for injuries sustained outside of supervised sessions.
- By signing up to an Acrosphere class, you acknowledge that participation may subject you to danger, and you accept these risks as part of the activity.
- Social media groups associated with Acrosphere must be parent run only and monitored
